

MEGHP,

The report of the Grand Treasurer is that the Grand Chapter is in good financial condition. As you and the companions know 2020 has been made a challenging year because of the pandemic.

Attached is the Treasurers Final Report for 2019, which normally is presented at the Semi-Annual convocation and is presented now. Also attached is the current status of the Trustees Reserve Fund as of September 30, 2020 take particular note of the loss of value in February and March of approximately 16% which almost entirely recovered by the end of August. Also please note that our EK Comp. Jeff Dill has completed his term as a trustee and should be replaced and also there is a vacancy created by the passing of MEPGHP Ponzillo. I would like to submit MEPGHP Randy Watson for one of those positions.

Attached is the Treasurers Interim Report for 2020 as of this date, there are a couple of notes for the companions to review, first is the missing Transfer Income amount. This transfer first set up by MEPGHP Ponzillo is taken from the proceeds of the Reserve Fund 80% of which is transferred to the Treasurers account to fund the budget. Second, the increase to the insurance costs will be offset by reimbursement of costs for the Grand Council and Grand Commandery.

Also attached is the proposed Budget for 2021, the only change being no expected costs for a Triennial.

7. Report of the Grand High Priest

M.E. Comp. Bruce G. Colburn, MEGHP

It has been an honor to represent the Royal Arch Masons of Maryland as your Grand High Priest. It was something I never really set out to attain, but continuous activity and the consideration of all of you led me here. Thank you. And thank you to all my line officers and committees who served during my term.

Looking back at my goals for this term, there were 5. Get the word out to every Master Mason about the Royal Arch, make our presence known by visibly assisting Blue Lodges with their activities and work, increase our number of ACTIVE members, organize a few social get-togethers for all our Chapters, and of course, degree work, degree work, degree work.

We were off to a decent start, with Lodge installation pin presentations giving us a chance to advertise the York Rite, a few Grand visitations to see Companions and let them know our plans, some encouraging degree work with a good number of new members, social activities were in the works....and then Covid-19 happened. And restrictive edicts followed. Because of that, our Semi-Annual was cancelled along with many travel and social activities.

I am truly sorry that I did not get around to see everyone, to share ideas and companionship. I wish that I had been able to make it to several other State Grand sessions, to share and discover ideas about how well we were doing in Maryland and to learn from others. And I was looking forward to hopefully seeing a good sized contingent from Maryland at the Triennial this year.

So, where are we and what did we do? Well, for one thing, we saved some expenses. We were able to award 3 scholarships, I believe of \$1500.00 each, to deserving college students. We still managed to raise funds for our scholarships and the RARA. And in a combined effort with the Grand Council and Grand Commandery, we assisted in the disbursement of more than \$5000.00, to 8 local food banks to help with the increased burden they are under.

I did attend several DeMolay functions prior to the lockdown, including the King's Bowling Tournament with DeMolay. The lockdown prevented me from attending Jobs Daughters and Rainbow Girls functions that were planned. Our Grand King represented us at the Grand Master's Annual Session, our Grand Scribe represented us at the Mayor's Christmas Parade.

I personally attended over 10 Lodge installations to present Master pins. I also managed 3 Grand visitations done before the lockdown. I represented the Royal Arch at the DeMolay and Grand Lodge services for Past Grand Master Steven J. Ponzillo.

While on the Knights Templar trip to Israel, I attended a Lodge in Jerusalem and presented Grand Chapter pins to their members. I even presided over two Zoom installations of Officers. I attended

the Low Vale Chapter degrees by Phoenix Chapter in September, and attended the first meeting of a new Lodge in Maryland, the Logia Sol Naciente No. 242, first Spanish Lodge.

We kept up our facebook and website presence, and maintained the monthly publishing of the Keystone newsletter, with over 300 subscribers. Our Grand Scribe began podcast interviews of numerous Grand Lodge and York Rite officers, placed on the York Rite website. We discovered what Zoom software was. I began a weekly online Royal Arch get together for those wishing to have a place to keep up on what was happening in Royal Arch Masonry in Maryland, and to see and talk to old friends and new ones. We drew the attention of the General Grand Chapter, and members and Grand officers from several other states joined in. Those weekly meetings have now been cut back to semi-weekly, but will continue for the near future, at the request of those who still feel at risk for getting out to a live meeting.

I have made the Zoom subscription use available to any Maryland Chapter that wishes to hold a Zoom meeting.

I had the unfortunate duty of closing Baltimore Chapter. Companion Aughenbaugh did a heroic job of keeping the Chapter in existence for several years while struggling to regain membership and activity, and working through his own health issues. However, after much discussion and thought, and concern for their lack of meeting, it became obvious to the Grand Chapter that merging their few remaining Companions into the next closest Chapter was the best course of action, giving their few active members a place to go. Of course, having everything shut down immediately after that was accomplished, has not given that the opportunity to work yet.

We may lose another Chapter in the near future, or the transfer of that charter from one area to another, which would be my hope. We are at that crossroads, I believe, where some re-organization of resources needs to be done. As we emerge from these pandemic restrictions, I believe that 12 to 14 active and flourishing Chapters can serve this State in good fashion, with plenty of Blue Lodges to draw from. I have always felt that Royal Arch should be the place where new brothers take that first step in learning the universality of Masonry, discovering and meeting Companions from Lodges other than their own.

In closing, I want to remind you once again of three important issues. One, we must strive to make our degree work as good or better than the Lodges we draw our members from. It makes not a good impression of our sincerity, if we are reading our parts. That is most important.

And two, remember our youth groups. As I mentioned at an earlier ceremony this year, when I read about the Cathedral of Notre Dame's roof burning, I found several articles about the fact that the stone masons used to plant trees near cathedrals, knowing that in some time in the future, the stone, the foundation, would last, but the wood in the roofs would need replacement. These

cathedral forests were meant for that purpose. Our Masonic youth groups are our cathedral forests. We will need them as replacements, to be placed on our foundations, for our teachings in the future. Do not just fund them, become active, or at least attend a meeting or two to let them know who we are and that we care more than just by writing checks.

Third, to those of us above a certain age. You can probably remember a time when Grand Sessions would be overflowing with members, any Chapter meeting consisted of more than 12 members, and many of your worker friends and neighbors were also Masons. Back then, you received regular mailings of activities, carpooling was used to attend events, phone calls were a regular way of communicating, and ritual practice was done on a regular basis.

Well, you can help get things back to that activity level, but you've got to get with the new communications. Don't sit back and watch. Take the time to figure some of this new "stuff" out, or ask a newer member to help you, they'll be glad too. And get involved. Your knowledge, ideas, and memories of what went on before are an important part of what happens next. You're not being left out of the loop, you need to grab hold of the loop. And those who feel safe in attending live meetings under our current situation, don't forget about those who for their own safety are refraining from attending. Don't let them feel left out. Communication is more important now than ever.

There will be a new Grand High Priest now, and already a new Most Illustrious Grand Master, and soon a new Most Worshipful Grand Master. I am sure we will be in good hands for the future. So stay safe, wash your hands, wear the mask. And keep communicating.

I would end with what I have ended many of my Keystone newsletters with, the way the original High Priests were told by God, through Moses, to bless his people, as found in Numbers Chapter 6, verses 24-26;

The Lord bless you and keep you, The Lord make his face shine on you, And be gracious to you.

The Lord turn his face towards you, And give you peace.

The Committee reports that all Convocations were suspended from March through August. Some Chapters conducted "virtual" meetings via the Zoom App, but most relied on email and telephone contacts to check on member Companions and apprise them of the current state of affairs in lieu of suspended specific York Rite activities.
