The proposed change is to increase the chapter assessment paid to support the Maryland Council of Anointed High Priests from Thirty dollars (\$30.00) to Forty dollars (\$40.00).

Article VI

Fees and Dues to the Grand Chapter

Section 3: With the annual returns payments for exaltations and annual assessments, each Chapter shall pay to the Grand Chapter by October 1 of each year the sum of <u>Thirty Dollars</u> Forty <u>Dollars</u> for the support of the Maryland Council of Anointed High Priests. Prior to the annual meeting of the Maryland Council of Anointed High Priests, the Grand Treasurer shall forward payment of the total collected from the Chapters, without the need for any vote or other authorizing action by the Grand Chapter or Grand High Priest.

3. Annual Proceedings

M.E. Comp. William Eppig, AGr. Sec.

MEGHP,

The Proceedings of the 2021 Semi-Annual Grand Convocation have been available on the Grand Chapter website since May 2021. As the 2021 Semi-Annual Proceeding has been available for inspection and review and will continue to be so, I move that they be accepted as posted, subject to further correction should any cause be found.

It was moved and seconded to accept the report, passed unanimously.

4. Report of the Grand Secretary

M.E. Comp. William C. Eppig, Asst. GS

Most Excellent Grand High Priest,

It is with pleasure I give the Grand Secretaries report with the permission of Grand Secretary Vernon Huebschman. It has been an exciting year working with Vern and learning all the responsibilities, duties, and idiosyncrasies of this new position. Vern has allowed me to take an active part this year. He has allowed me to take on many of his responsibilities for the opportunity to learn and get a feel for what is to come. I thank him for his confidence and the many years of insight he has given to me this past year.

Annual Reports: A summary of the Annual Reports for 2021 has been submitted and is on the back of the agenda. We have two delinquent Chapter reports, and their returns will be based on the 2020 return. I will submit the final report for Maryland to the General Grand Chapter after the Session. Completing an Annual Report is a requirement for all chapters, and there should be little or no reason they are not completed before the due date.

The Dues cards have been printed for those chapters that have submitted a report and are at the desk for the Secretary or representative to pick up. I apologize to the chapters that have the correct name, but the wrong number printed on their cards could not reprint when discovered. Please make the change on your own.

I thank all the chapters that submitted their reports and quickly responded when follow-up was needed.

Annual Report Recommendations:

- 1. Begin completing the Annual Report in July during summer break. In most cases, the report can be completed in full, with minor adjustments before the due date. You can also submit earlier than the due date.
- 2. Verify the math on the form. We always have some errors and must contact the Chapter for replacement checks. This prolongs the process.
- 3. Mail your report with checks. It adds to the duty of the Grand Secretary to monitor the payment status when not included with the report. If emailing, please mail the check the same day.
- 4. Get them in early (Aug and Sept). The Grand Secretary must use this information to print dues cards. Printing is a time-consuming process. It took about 4-5 hours to Access and print these cards for the 13 chapters reported this year. On top of verifying the information, recording the information in the database, and notifying if errors are found. This is all done while preparing for October Session.

IRS 990N: A banner on the gateway page of yorkritemaryland.org links to the most expeditious route to the IRS 990N submission page. A few chapters did not complete the filing this year, noting it is not required every year by the IRS, and a filing was submitted last year. The Grand Chapter requires that the 990n filing be entered every year. This will make sure the Chapter is in the habit of filing, so it is never forgotten, especially if a secretary change is made.

If a chapter fails to file for three straight years, it will lose its IRS status and will take time and effort to get it back. Maintaining the Not-for-Profit status is necessary to have an Employer Identification Number or EIN. Without the EIN, banks and financial institutions will not do business or establish accounts to serve your Chapter.

Petition Vetting: Reminder that this Grand Chapter requires that the Grand Secretary must vet all prospective members of Royal Arch before they may receive their degrees. You must send name, contact Information, Lodge, and GL# to me. I will verify they are a Maryland Mason in good standing and have stood proficiency in the MM Degree. This must be done 72hrs or longer before they join. Members who live in other jurisdictions must receive dispensation for the jurisdiction in which they live and is done through the Grand Secretary, and more time will be needed. No dispensation is necessary for a member who lives in Maryland but is a member of an out-of-state lodge, be sure he is in good standing in his home lodge. If you are in any doubt, contact the Grand Secretary.

The School for Secretaries, Recorders, and Treasurers: We are discussing how the 2022 school will be handled and what form it will take. It has been suggested to open the school to a broader range of presentations that would benefit the Secretaries, Recorders Treasurers, and other leaders of the bodies. In the meantime, if you need assistance or ideas, you can go to the York Rite website/resources and find information and video from this February's zoom meeting or contact the Grand Officers.

Website and Tech: We are continuing to update and improve the York Rite website. In most cases, you can save a call or email and find what you may need there. Chapter contacts and locations, necessary forms, and event dates and times can all be found on the website. You can also visit the General Grand Chapter website for more information.

We are always looking into more ways to improve the operation of the chapters and make the Secretary's work more accessible. So far this year, we have done the following:

A standard Demit Form and Chapter Affiliation Petition have been produced and are available to the Chapter Secretaries through the Grand Secretary. It was revealed that our chapters had no common form to give to a demitting member or a simple petition to use for affiliation.

This year, the online electronic payment was introduced for the Grand Session and seemed well received. This process will be used by the Grand Chapter when events warrant. A chapter is in

the process of testing electronic payment for the collection of Chapter dues. If all goes well, it could be made available to any chapter wishing to use this system.

The idea of reporting newly exalted members on a regular basis instead of yearly (Annual Report) has been suggested. This would allow them to receive the Royal Arch Magazine immediately and hopefully make it easier to complete the Annual report. We will investigate this suggestion.

If you have any ideas or suggestions to make the operational aspects of your Chapter easier, I am open and eager to hear them.

Grand Chapter Officer Regalia: The Grand Chapter loans the Grand Officers regalia consisting of a Collar, Apron, and Apron case representing their Office. In years past, we have had a problem with these items being returned at the end of the year. This causes a financial burden on this Grand Chapter for their replacement. It can cost up to \$800 to replace the average set.

Beginning this year, we will have the Grand Officers sign for their regalia to keep a record of who receives and what is received. It will be your responsibility to see they are returned for the next Grand Session. Most sets are complete, with a few noted exceptions. I will have a register at the desk for each of you to sign before Installation.

Most Excellent Grand High Priest-elect, we will need to discuss if you will continue some of the practices granted to the Grand Secretary to make your job easier. They include notifications, dispensations given to chapters, and anything else you think would help you this year.

I like to congratulate all the Officers for the 2021-2022 Capitular year. I look forward to assisting you as you work diligently to bring Maryland Royal Arch to the forefront of the Masons of Maryland.

The report of the Grand Treasurer is that the Grand Chapter is in good financial condition. As you and the companions know, 2021 has been a challenging year as we recover from the pandemic.

Attached is the Treasurers Interim Report for 2021. Also attached is the status of the Trustees Reserve Fund as of September 30, 2021. Of particular note is the gain in value from November 1 to August 31 of approximately 22%, unfortunately keeping in mind the geopolitical activities of that time, we suffered a loss of market value from August 31 to September 30 of \$38,205.09 or 7%. We do not recommend any changes as we expect the market to recover as it usually does.

7. Report of the Grand High Priest

Companions,

I would like to welcome everyone to the Annual Grand Convocation here in Ocean City and thank you for your support of your Grand Chapter.

I would also like to thank the MEGHP's in attendance today. It is through your dedication and diligence, and advice that this Grand Chapter continues to help our Chapters grow and prosper. Also, to the Grand Officers and committee members who give of their time and talents to assist in this task.

I would like to thank MIGM Randolph Disney and REGC Charles Warns, for their cooperation, friendship, and dedication to our great fraternity. We all know that one body cannot exist without the other. This is true **York Rite Unity.**

I have seen this unity this year as those Chapters, Councils, and Commandries that meet in the same place have started to consider themselves as York Rite Centers.

Doings & Edicts

During this last year, there were not many occasions for edicts or doings. Thanks to our Grand Secretary, most dispensations for wavier of jurisdiction and any other general dispensations were granted with no action needed on my part.





Membership Report 2021

Reviewing the Grand Chapter Proceedings, the data for the time period ranging from 2011 to 2021 was analyzed. The following is a summary of that analysis.

- Overall membership has declined 463 members since 2011, with the sharpest decline occurring between 2016 and 2018, when membership dropped by 259 members. Membership was roughly level from 2011-2013 and from 2018-2020.
- Three Chapters have merged since 2018 (number of Chapters dropped from 19 to 16) with possibly one more to merge soon.
- 5-year trend (19 Chapters): (6) Chapters had positive growth
 - (12) Chapters went negative, with (1) remaining level
- 3-year trend (16 Chapters): (2) Chapters had positive growth
 - o (10) Chapters went negative, with (4) remaining level
- **Degree work** Exaltations:
 - Exaltations are about half of what they were just 2 years ago and 1/3 from 7 years ago.
 - (2) Chapters have had no exaltations in 5 years with (3) others performing <5 in that timeframe
 - (3) Chapters have had no exaltations in 4 years with (3) others performing <4 in that timeframe
 - (3) Chapters have had no exaltations in 3 years with (4) others performing <3 in that timeframe
 - Note: 2020-21 was also the time of Covid-19 shutdown. (We need to track the
 exaltation trend closely to determine whether this sharp decrease was an anomaly
 or something that will be continuing.)
- One Chapter has grown by 16% in membership the last 3 years (23% in the last 4 years).
- Royal Arch Freemasonry <u>continues to hold</u> >10% of Blue Lodge Membership (8-year analysis: avg. 10.31%)





In conclusion, Chapters need to resume and, where possible, increase their labors. If they need to enlist the help of the Grand Chapter, please request it — our Chapters need to be active. Chapters need to get their exhalation numbers up, as there is no reason Royal Arch Freemasonry in Maryland could not grow to 15 or 20% of Blue Lodge Membership. We should be growing as much as possible, even as Blue Lodge numbers recede. Finally, Grand Chapter needs to continuously track our trends in membership, so we constantly have a finger on the pulse concerning the health of Royal Arch Freemasonry in Maryland and actively use this information to assist in our long-term planning.
