The Proceedings of the 2022 Semi-Annual Grand Convocation have been available on the Grand Chapter website since May 2022. As the 2022 Semi-Annual Proceeding has been available for inspection and review and will continue to be so, I move that they be accepted as posted, subject to further correction should any cause be found.

It was moved and seconded to accept the report and passed unanimously.

4. Report of the Grand Secretary

Most Excellent Grand High Priest,

My first year as Grand Secretary has come to an end, and it has been an enjoyable and excellent learning experience. I like to thank all the Chapter Secretaries for the dedication they have and support they have given to their Chapter over the last year. Congratulations to the 2021-2022 Grand Officers for their outstanding support of Maryland Royal Arch.

Annual Reports: A summary of the Annual Reports for 2022 has been submitted and is on the back of the agenda. All but one Chapter submitted their report by the deadline, and all fees had been paid. I received the late Chapter's report last week and waiting on the assessment to be paid. After the Session, I will submit a final report for Maryland to the General Grand Chapter in November.

The Dues cards have been printed for all the chapters and are at the desk for the secretary or representative to pick up after this meeting.

I thank all the chapters that submitted their reports by the deadline and quickly responded when follow-up was needed. This made the reporting and printing dues cards so much easier this year.

New for next year's Annual Report:

1. Beginning next year, I will ask the chapter secretaries to send me the names and contacts of their newly elected and installed officers. This requirement is written in the Constitution and will help in communications and mailing the Annual Call Letter.

2. I have asked Comp. Rodriguez to adjust the Annual Report form to automatically tabulate the returns on page 15. This should help prevent future mistakes.

Piscataway Chapter: Piscataway Chapter # 46 was officially closed during the Semi-Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter held on May 12, 2022.

The Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Robert W. Chase, took this action in accordance with Article XII, section 3 of the Constitution. Most Excellent Grand High Priest Robert Chase granted the Chapter's members a dispensation to maintain affiliated and active status until August 31, 2022, but they had to inform the Grand Secretary where they would like to transfer their membership to a new chapter to stay in active status.

A letter was sent to all Piscataway members, and two reminder emails were sent to the membership through the High Priest of the Chapter. I received a request from 6 of the members asking for a transfer. One member was not reported by the Chapter and, after verification, was added to the York Rite database. These members have been transferred to their requested Chapters, and the receiving Chapters added them to their roles.

Four members were dual members of another chapter. The rest were suspended due to lodge action or failure to respond to me by the deadline.

Monies left in Piscataway's account were recovered and sent to the Grand Chapter. Chapter property is in possession of PHP Matulewicz, and I will arrange to recover these items after the Session.

I.R.S. 990N: Reminder, it is required that every Chapter complete this filing every year. A banner on the gateway page of yorkritemaryland.org links the most expeditious route to the I.R.S. 990N submission page.

The School for Secretaries, Records, and Treasurers: We are discussing having a school in February 2023. It has been suggested to open the school to a broader range of presentations that would benefit the Secretaries, Records, Treasurers, and other leaders of the bodies. In the

meantime, if you need assistance or ideas, go to the York Rite website/resources and find information and video from the February 2020 zoom meeting.

Award Replenishment: At the Semi-Annual, I noted that the Grand Chapter needs to replenish its inventory of Awards. This was accomplished over the summer. I have a stock of these Awards at my home and the balance in the York Rite Office at the Grand lodge. We should have enough to cover many presentations in the coming years.

Award Recommendation: I suggest the Awards committee codify the current awards and structure. There is no "official" written listing of awards, what they are for, and requirements to earn or how to nominate. One or two need to be reviewed and requirements adjusted, or they need to be retired. Once this review is completed and the official list made, it can be added as an appendix or article to the Constitution and distributed to the membership. This list will allow the members better access and understanding of what is available. This year there seemed to be confusion on what the awards are for and who is eligible. For example, we had a nominate for the white tau for a companion who has been a member for over ten years. As well for the General Grand Chapter Ritual Award.

Most Excellent Grand High Priest-elect, we will need to discuss if you will continue some of the practices granted to the Grand Secretary to make your job easier. They include notifications, dispensations given to chapters, and anything else you think would help you this year.

I congratulate all the Officers for the 2023-2023 Capitular year. I look forward to assisting you as you work diligently to bring Maryland Royal Arch to the forefront of the Masons of Maryland.

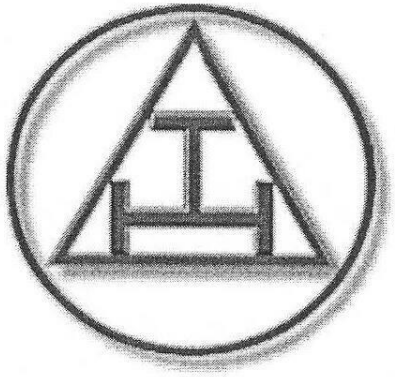

MEGHP,

The report of the Grand Treasurer is that the Grand Chapter is in good financial condition. As you and the companions know 2022 has been a challenge largely due to geopolitical activities.

Attached is the Treasurers Interim Report for 2022. Also attached is the status of the Trustees Reserve Fund as of September 30, 2022. Of particular note is the value from November 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. Looking at the 'change in value' shows the volatility in the market in decreases and increases in market values (up \$20K and down \$20K), overall, the fund is down almost 15%, not bad when you consider the Nasdaq from October 2021 to October 2022 is down 28%. Historically as periods of inflation, recession, or correction are resolved usually in a year or so the market recovers, the best advise remains to stay the course!

20. Report of Membership Committee

Overall, Royal Arch membership in Maryland dipped this year from 1130 to 1016 members*. One Chapter sadly is now gone; its books closed. Degree work is down, with only 19** exaltations in 2022. Three Chapters accounted for 12 of this number (4 each), with 8 of the remaining 15 Chapters creating no new Royal Arch Masons this year. The positive news is our Grand Chapter of Maryland is holding its own, still maintaining over a ratio of >10%*** of the total number of Blue Lodge Masons, with 4 of our Chapters growing in membership this year (up from 1 last year).

What can we do to stem the downward trend? We can continue growing our ritualist core and buttress the front line with all Chapters being able to confer our degrees. We need to invigorate our Chapters that are not exalting men to the Royal Arch with the importance of doing so. We must continue to send the signal that to finish the Blue Lodge story lies within the Royal Arch. We need to show Brothers the light of the Royal Arch and what it means to be called Companion. If your Chapter needs help, your Grand Chapter has the resources to assist on many levels for ritual, management, and programs. The ritual school held this summer not only strengthened the ritual of 13 already accomplished ritualists who attended but, more importantly, brought seven new ritualists to the table. Our Grand Lecturers do much to create new High Priests, and we thank them for all the hours they put into helping our ritualist numbers grow. Thank you both, and thank you to all the Companions who keep the ritual fire burning in your Chapters.

21. Reports to be Received and Published requiring no action M.E. Robert Lumbert. P.G.H.P.

The 2022 Northeast Regional Conference was held in Albany on September 9 and 10. I attended the Chapter / Council part on Friday. M.E.G.H.P. Chase has asked me to report on what went on.

The Chapter / Council Day is spent half on Masonic education and half on Chapter / Council business. The first educational talk was titled "The Indispensable Obligation: The Esoteric Teachings of Masonic Prayer". That makes it sound like the talk would be uninteresting, but such was not the case. I learned a lot, and I only wish I could have taken more notes. I apologize for only giving short statements of some points the speaker made, omitting much of his elaboration.

When Masonry was simply operative Masonry, it was a Christian organization. But as it became more speculative, that changed. The universality of religion is found in the first Constitution in 1723. The Grand Lodge then provided prayers, as they do now. We looked at two specific ones. The first was from the Irish Grand Lodge in 1730. The prayer is 4 or 5 paragraphs long. But one of those paragraphs is very close to the prayer we use in the Entered Apprentice degree when the candidate first enters the Lodge. A version by Preston in the 1770s is even closer, differing by only one phrase. I believe he said that this prayer is used by almost all Grand Lodges. I didn't write much about the second prayer, from 1756. But some of its words date back to something called the Arabeck Cantina, from the 4th century.

The phrase "wisdom and understanding" is heard a lot. It occurs in Exodus 36:1 referring to the builders Moses, Aholiab and Bezalel, and in I Kings 7:14 concerning Hiram Abiff. One of the teachings of early masonry was that divine Wisdom was too much for normal people to understand, and so you needed the secrets of Masonry to process and comprehend it.

The other big part of the talk was on what is called Traditional History. This is the stories within Masonry which sound like they come from the Bible but don't. Masons traditionally adopted the persona of Biblical characters for teaching, going back to Adam, Seth and Enoch. One of the things that Enoch did was to construct two pillars to protect the world's knowledge through the universal disaster that he knew was coming. He didn't know whether the disaster would be in the form of fire or flood, so he made one for each possibility. We find this represented in our ritual in the phrase "against inundation and conflagration". I understand that in some other jurisdictions the main character in the Council degrees is Enoch, rather than Solomon, as in ours.

Then came Noah. Many of you know that Noah was an important figure in early Masonic degree work. The ark was actually a Lodge. And the body of Adam was carried in the ark. He said that he wanted to be buried by a priest, so they had to carry his body around until priests were invented. The Tower of Babel was a Masonic project. It was initially acceptable to God, but lost His favor because there were too many cowans and eavesdroppers involved.

The second talk was by Chad Burks, the General Grand Scribe, on "Clandestine Masonry". He started by differentiating between irregular masonry, which is work done without proper authority, and clandestine masonry, where one is initiated by unlawful means. The Grand Lodge of England, the Conference of Grand Masters and the Prince Hall Conference of Grand Masters are the three Bodies which decide on irregularity.

He then went into a brief history of types of clandestine masonry starting with Lodges of Adoption in France, where female relatives of members were permitted to join. This led to female-only Lodges, as well as mixed Lodges. In 1999 the Grand Lodge of England acknowledged two female Grand Lodges, saying they were regular in all respects, except for admitting women.

There is a lot of irregular masonry. Some Lodges don't have a Charter, because it was lost or they never bothered to get one in the first place. Many of these Lodges are within the Prince Hall system. Somewhere there is a "Museum of Clandestine Masonry".

While some of the clandestine "Masonic" bodies may be relatively harmless, there are dangerous ones out there as well. One scam is run by men who accost a man wearing a Masonic ring and tell him to "Defend the Light". He is asked questions, and, when he is unable to answer, his ring is taken. He is told to go back to his Lodge for more instruction, and, when that is accomplished, the Worshipful Master will give him his ring back. Of course, the ring is never given to the Worshipful Master in question. It ends up on eBay.

But it gets much worse. Some supposed Lodges charge thousands of dollars for a degree and collect hundreds of dollars in monthly dues. The candidates are abused in various ways, such as being branded, and some die. One such organization is the "Masonic Police Department", whose badge has the Eastern Star symbol on it. Unfortunately, the public and the media can't tell the difference between this Masonry and regular Masonry, and irregular Masonry seems to be growing faster than the regular kind.

Due to the interest aroused by this talk, Companion Burks said he would prepare a 10-minute video on the subject. If he has completed this, I'm not aware of this. But this is information we need to get out to the members of all York Rite bodies, including Lodges, and to their families as well.

In his remarks later Teko Foly said that he is very familiar with these issues, due to all the foreign, especially African and Latin American, bodies that he has to deal with.

There was one other educational talk, titled "Wisdom Dwells with Contemplation". I did not get much out of the talk.

We had a breakout session, where we broke up into groups of about four, based on where we were sitting, to discuss a particular topic. In the past this has been a productive exercise, with some good ideas emerging. That was not the case this year. The topic was "Marketing: Public and

the Blue Lodge". There weren't any new ideas to come out of the discussion. And there was a big focus on marketing Blue Lodge, but people felt that was the responsibility of Grand Lodges, and not other York Rite bodies.

As usual, there were presentations on R.A.R.A. and C.M.M.R.F., which I didn't think much of. The person who was supposed to do the R.A.R.A. presentation didn't show up, and the person who volunteered to replace him wasn't prepared. The C.M.M.R.F. presentation was by the head researcher at Indiana University. The talk was aimed at the people in the audience who had medical degrees, of which there were about 0.

The Conference concluded with items from the General Grand bodies. Steve Tiner and Teko Foly spoke for General Grand Chapter, and Tom Taylor for General Grand Council. It was all things I had heard before. There are three Companions from the Northeast running for elective office in Branson next August, in addition to the three already in office - James McNeely from Connecticut for General Grand Scribe, Dennis Sheridan from New Hampshire for General Grand Secretary, and Mark Irwin from Delaware for General Grand Recorder. Also, Piers Vaughn from New York will be the Regional Deputy General Grand High Priest for the Northeast.

This has become a worthwhile event over the past few years, and the leadership (and future leadership) of the Grand Chapter and Grand Council in Maryland should be attending. This should become easier in the future if the plans to have a MidAtlantic Region (and hence a MidAtlantic Regional Conference) are fulfilled. The format of the Northeast Conference would serve as a good model for our own Conference.

Last, but not least, thank you to my children and my wife, Diana. I could not do what I do for Freemasonry without your limitless support. I love all three of you so much.
