Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Maryland Annual Convocation

Proposed Constitution changes to be voted on at the Annual Meeting of the Grand Chapter of Maryland on October 26, 2024. Proposed by G. Andrew Martinez, GHP

Proposed Changes: (in Bold and underlined)

Article 6, Section 4: The Grand Lecturer <u>and/or Deputy Grand Lecturer</u> shall visit all the Subordinate Chapters in the jurisdiction at least once every year, and impart to them such instructions, as they may need. The Grand Lecturer <u>and/or Deputy Grand Lecturer</u> shall report at each Annual Convocation the condition of the several Chapters. The Grand Lecturer <u>and Deputy Grand Lecturers</u> shall be paid for <u>their services</u>, from the funds of the Grand Chapter, <u>his</u> the actual expenses incurred, and such sum as may be fixed from time to time by resolution of the Grand Chapter.

Article XII, Section 5, (b), 1, b

He must be certified by the Grand Lecturer <u>or Deputy Grand Lecturer</u> as meeting the current standards for Ritual proficiency.

Article XII, Section 5, (b), 3, a

Attend the Annual Law School conducted by the Grand Lecturer or Deputy Grand Lecturer.

<u>Justification:</u> This will hopefully relieve some of the pressure on the GL position and add some flexibility in covering all of the GL's responsibilities should he be unavailable.

3. Annual Proceedings

M.E.G.H.P.,

The Proceedings of the 2024 Semi-Annual Grand Convocation have been available on the Grand Chapter website since May 2024. As the 2024 Semi-Annual Proceeding has been available for inspection and review and will continue to be so, I move that they be accepted as posted, subject to further correction should any cause be found.

4. Report of the Grand Secretary

MEGHP,

I want to thank all the chapter secretaries for their dedication and support to their chapters over the last year, especially in implementing the membership system.

Annual Reports: A summary of the 2024 Annual Reports has been submitted and is on the back of the agenda. All but one Chapter submitted their reports by the deadline, and all fees have been paid. After the Session, I will submit a final report for Maryland and an assessment to the General Grand Chapter in November.

We are officially using the new Masonic Membership Solutions database, which has been open to the secretaries since June. Most secretaries have been adapting to it, but a few are still getting used to it. One advantage of the system is that we were able to shorten the Annual Report submitted to the Grand Chapter from 15 pages to just 3. They can utilize the annual report from the MMS but must delete any plural members from the count to not pay an assessment for them since the home chapter is responsible for that.

Another advantage is that we now have a more accurate membership count for the Grand Chapter of Maryland, with the Chapters and the Grand Chapters Databases being the same.

Last year, the chapters reported 962 members, but the Grand Chapter had just over 1000 members listed. I worked with several chapters to align our list, but it was not easy with the many changes in Secretaries over the four years.

As reported by the chapters and the MMS, we currently have 896 members. This is a deduction of 66 after the conversion.

By using the new MMS, we can have our Dues cards printed by the same company that prints the Commandery and Scottish Rite dues cards. They are more professional-looking and can be mailed using a window envelope instead of the secretary taking the time to address an envelope to send the card to the member.

The Dues cards for all the chapters have been printed and are at the desk for the secretary or representative to pick up after this meeting. The company includes a printout of the chapter membership on which the cards are based.

I encourage all secretaries here and any High Priest and elected line to review the provided dues card member list and make any necessary corrections. Membership systems only work as well as the information inputted into the system. We started well and will only get better.

The system is also open for each member to view their profile and have the ability to adjust or add information as needed. And I encourage them to do so.

The next item on the agenda is to cross-reference lodge deaths and suspensions with ours and notify the Grand Council and Commandery of those individuals.

All donations from our Chapters to Royal Arch Research Assistance have been mailed to the General Grand Chapter Coordinator.

Secretary and Recorder School: I am considering holding a Secretary / Recorder School in February 2025. We have had several changes over the last year, which should benefit them. Plus, we can refresh on the MMS.

Donations: This past year, we received requests from Delmar Job's Daughters and Maryland DeMolay for donations to assist in purchasing T-shirts for the Job's Daughters Supreme session and sponsorship for DeMolay Conclave. We donated \$200 to both and received lovely thank-you notes. The Grand Chapter helped sponsor an ice cream truck at the Conclave. It was well received during a hot July Saturday.

This is a preferable way to donate than just writing a check. The money will go to something the youth need and have directed.

RAM Magazine: Since we have an accurate Membership list, I will send it to the Royal Arch Magazine. We will save money by sending it to fewer members; the address should be correct.

Most Excellent Grand High Priest Martinez, working with you over the last two years was a pleasure. Your dedication to this Grand Chapter and to the Royal Arch in general is exemplary. I know that with the Excellent King's resignation, you have been working with R.E. Scribe Rodrguez to help prepare him for the following year. We have no debt; you have left us in good hands for the next two years. Congratulations on an outstanding two years!

He must be certified by the Grand Lecturer <u>or Deputy Grand Lecturer</u> as meeting the current standards for Ritual proficiency.

Article XII, Section 5, (b), 3, a

Attend the Annual Law School conducted by the Grand Lecturer or Deputy Grand Lecturer.

<u>Justification:</u> This will hopefully relieve some of the pressure on the GL position and add some flexibility in covering all of the GL's responsibilities should he be unavailable.
